<p><u>FAFSA</u> The FAFSA is a free application for Federal Student Aid that is used to determine students' eligibility for post-secondary financial aid. We encourage all of our seniors to complete this application to see if they qualify for financial assistance to help pay for college or a technical program. The website is: https://fafsa.gov/</p> <p>The Florida Department of Education, Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA), administers a variety of state-funded grants and scholarships to assist Florida residents with the cost of their postsecondary education. This Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) can be submitted at: http://www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org/SSFAD/home/uamain.htm Completing this application serves several purposes, including applying for all the various levels of the Bright Futures Scholarship.
